

May 16 Trail Workday and Training Session: The US Forest Service will be providing training on trail maintenance for Trail Adopters and workday Volunteer Crew Leaders.

We will meet at 8:30 am at the Chicken Creek Trailhead on CR 42 just west of Transfer Campground, 10.5 miles north of Mancos. Google map link: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/526kZzdmYScnrZFr5>

The training will consist of discussion about volunteer agreements, safety, group leadership, sustainable trail design and trail hydrology, with hands-on demonstration of basic maintenance tasks. Anyone that has not attended past trainings and is leading groups of other volunteers or operating independently is highly encouraged to attend. (No problem with people attending more than once either 😊). The session will run until about 3:00 pm.

Please come prepared like a regular workday. Wear appropriate clothing for outdoor work including sturdy footwear, gloves, and eye protection. Bring water, snacks, sunscreen, bug dope if you use it, and rain protection. Plan to let us know if you carry special medications with you.

Lunch will be provided by Mancos Trails Group. Bring a chair and plan to stay and socialize for awhile.
